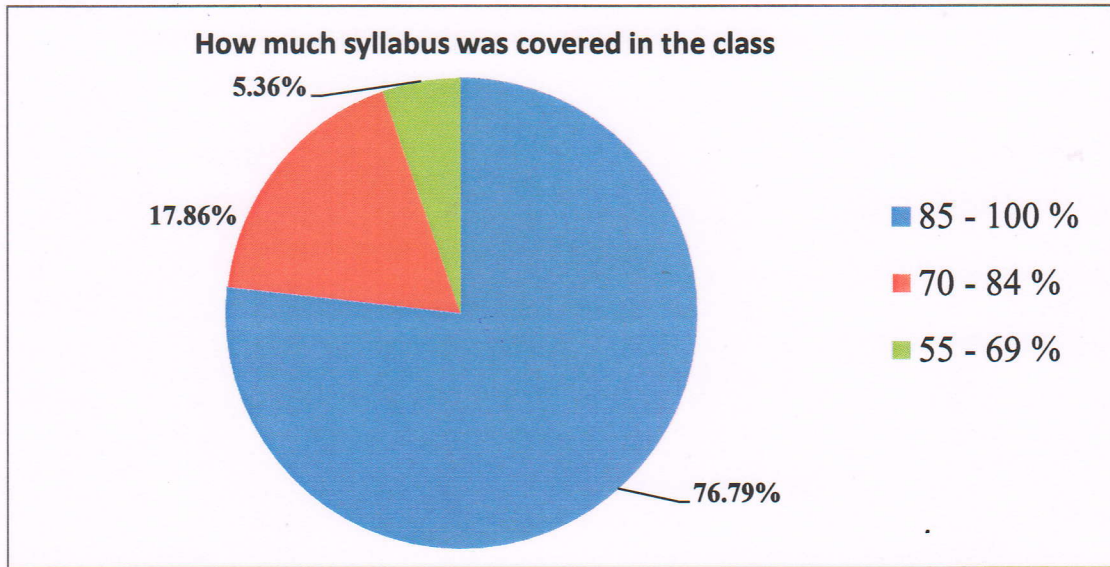
❖ Methodology:

At the end of the academic year 2023-24, the link to the Students Satisfaction Survey form (SSS) was made available to students. Students were notified to fill up the questionnaire. The questionnaire including 21 questions was prepared according to NAAC guidelines. Filling up SSS is voluntary/ optional. For the academic year 2023-24, there were 190 registered students at the college. Out of this 112 students responded to the survey.

❖ Respondent Profile:

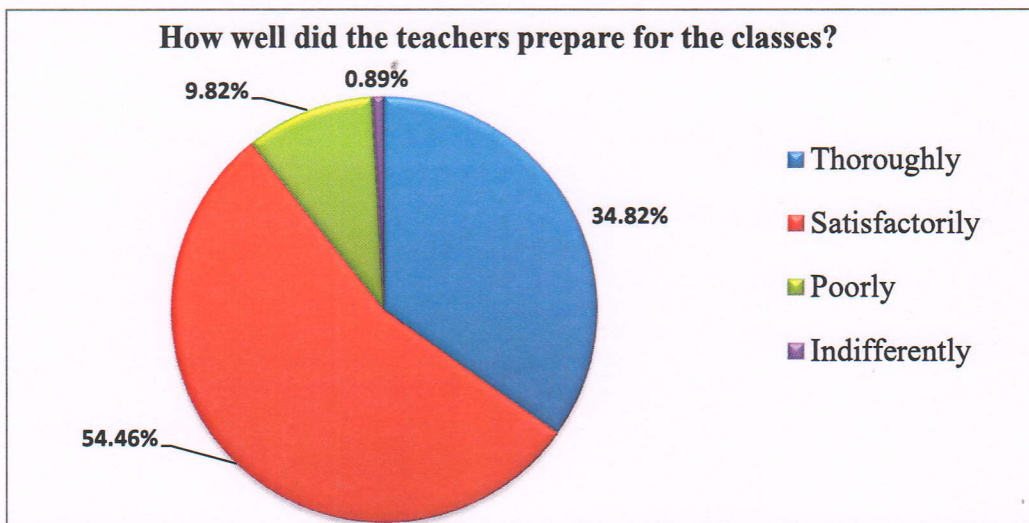

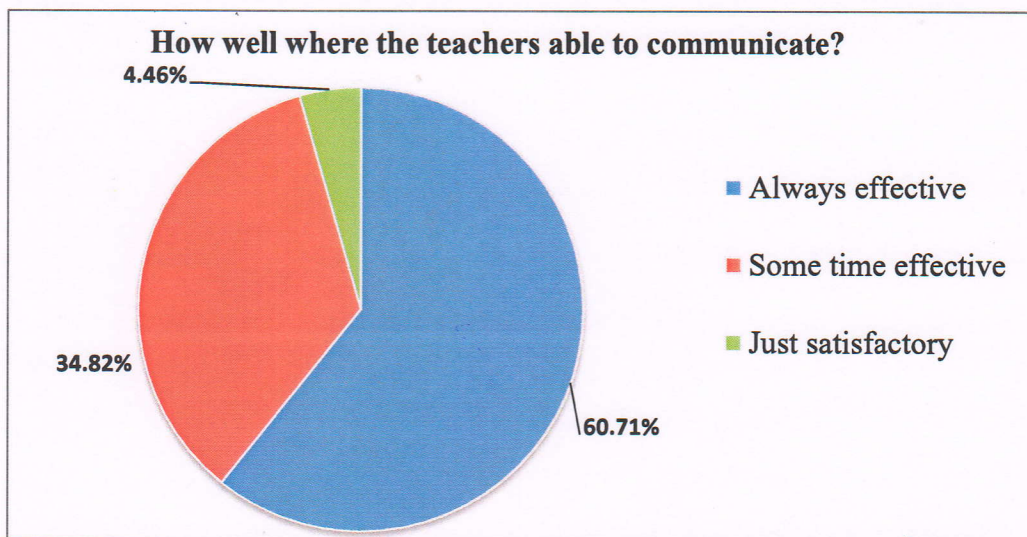

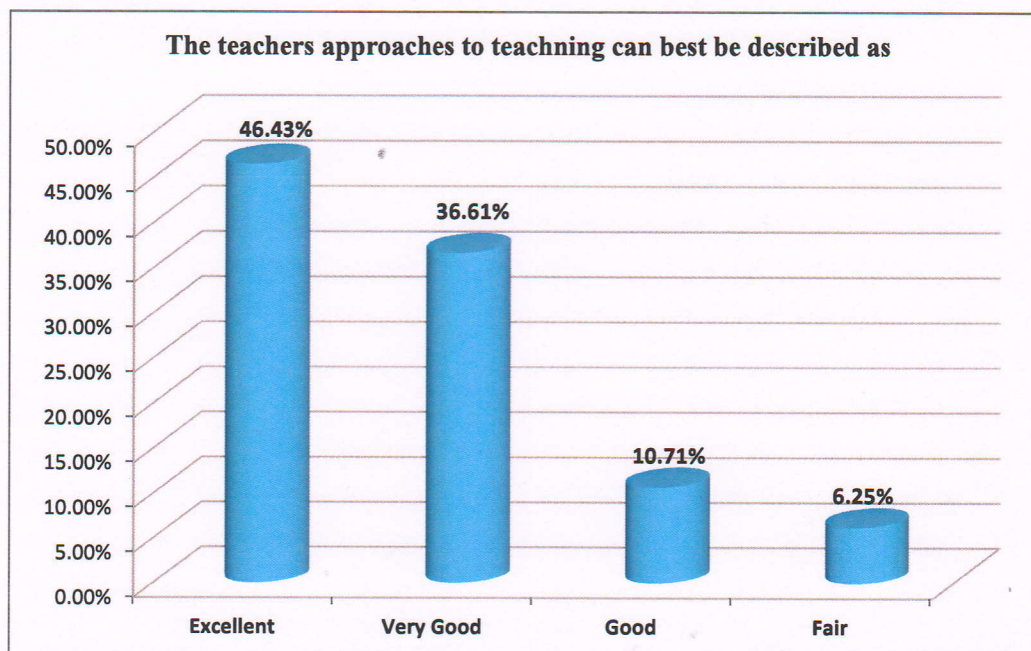
Q.3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

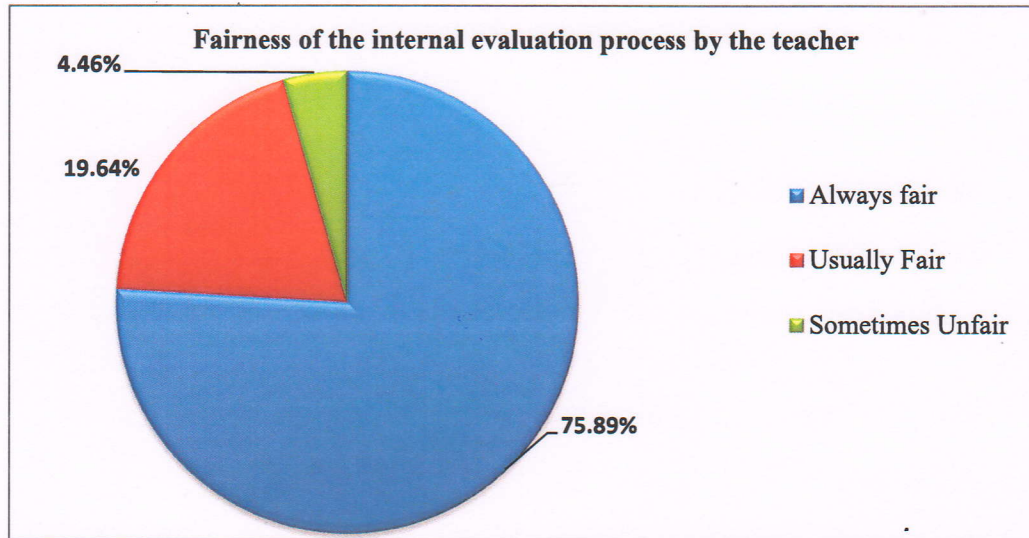
Q.4. The teachers approaches to teaching can best be described as

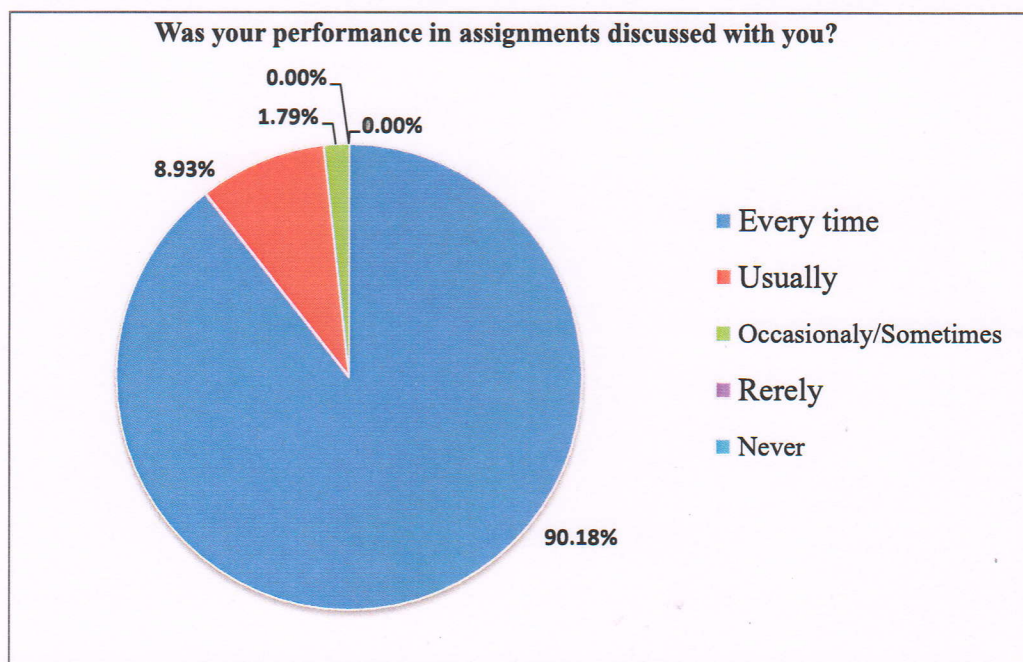
Q.5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teacher

Q.6 Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

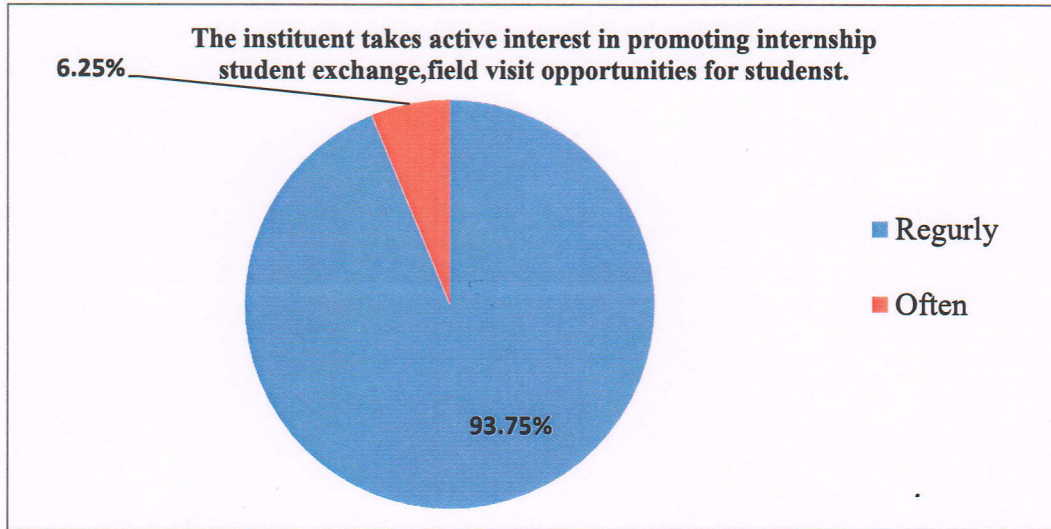

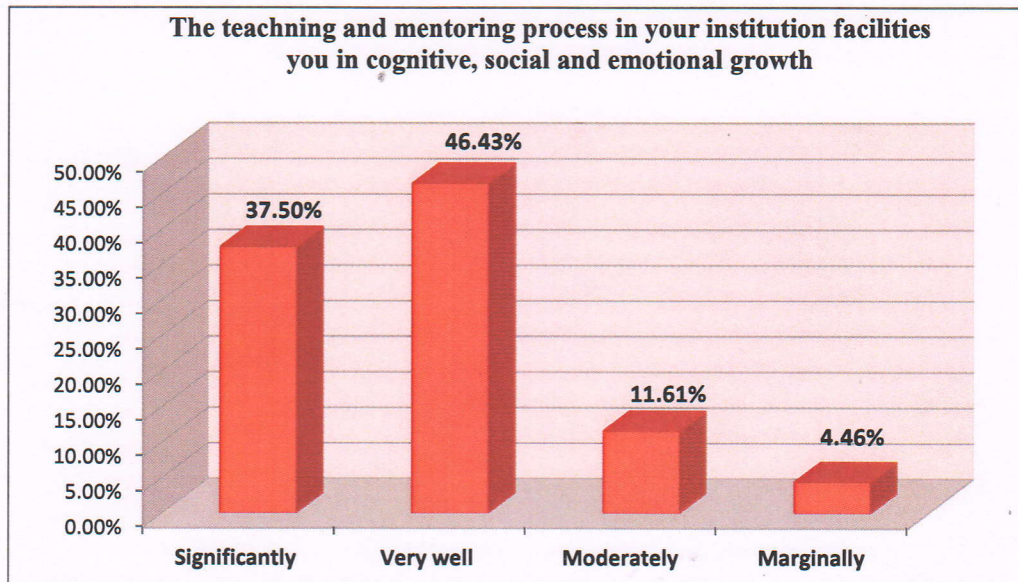

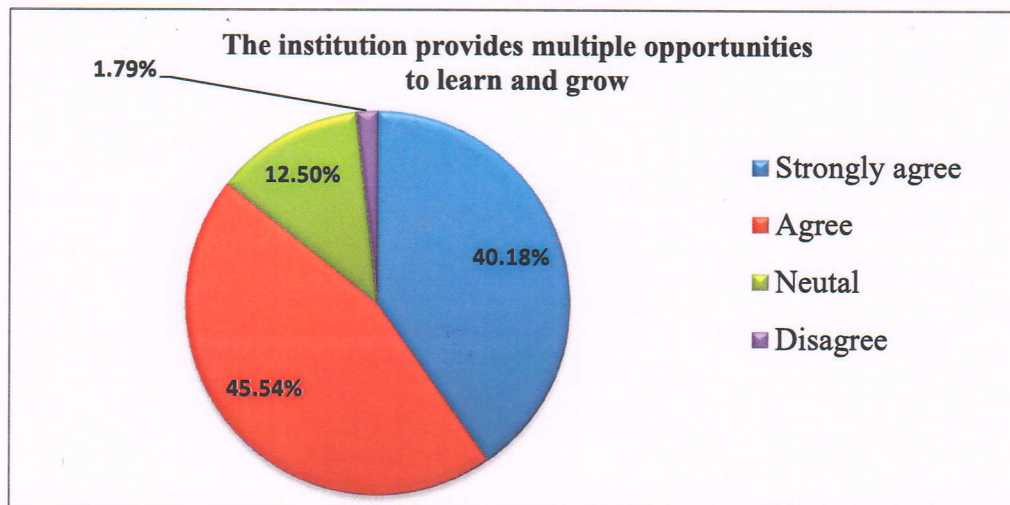
Q.8. The teachning and mentoring process in your institution facilities you in cognitive,social and emotional growth

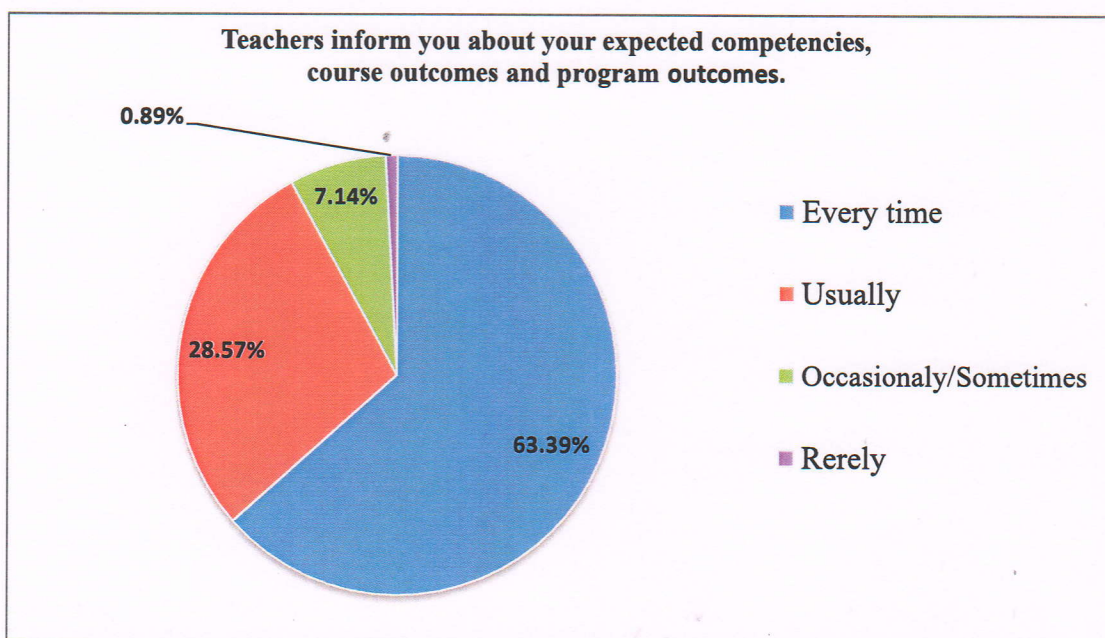
Q.9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow

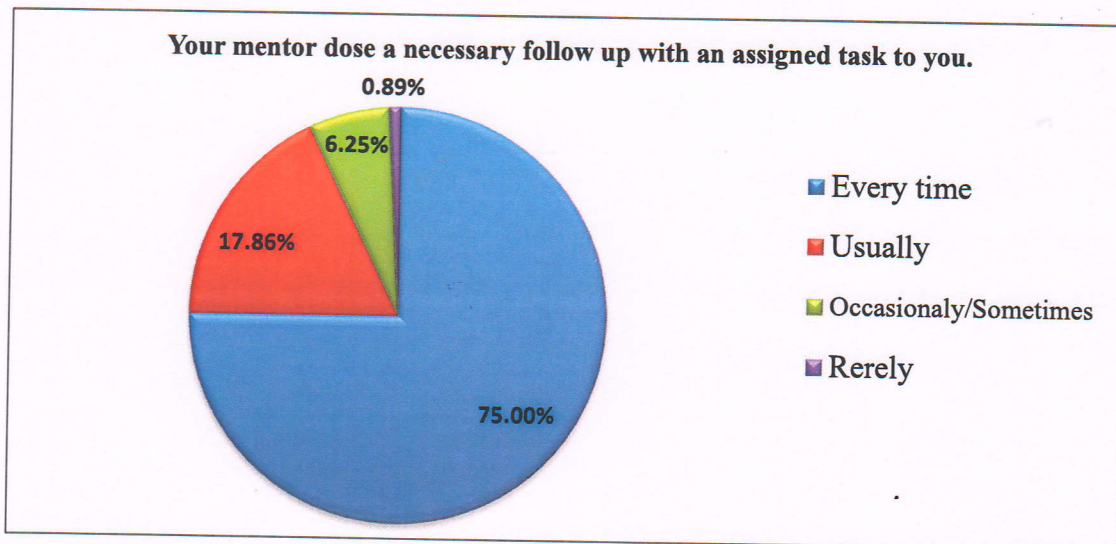
Q.10 Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.

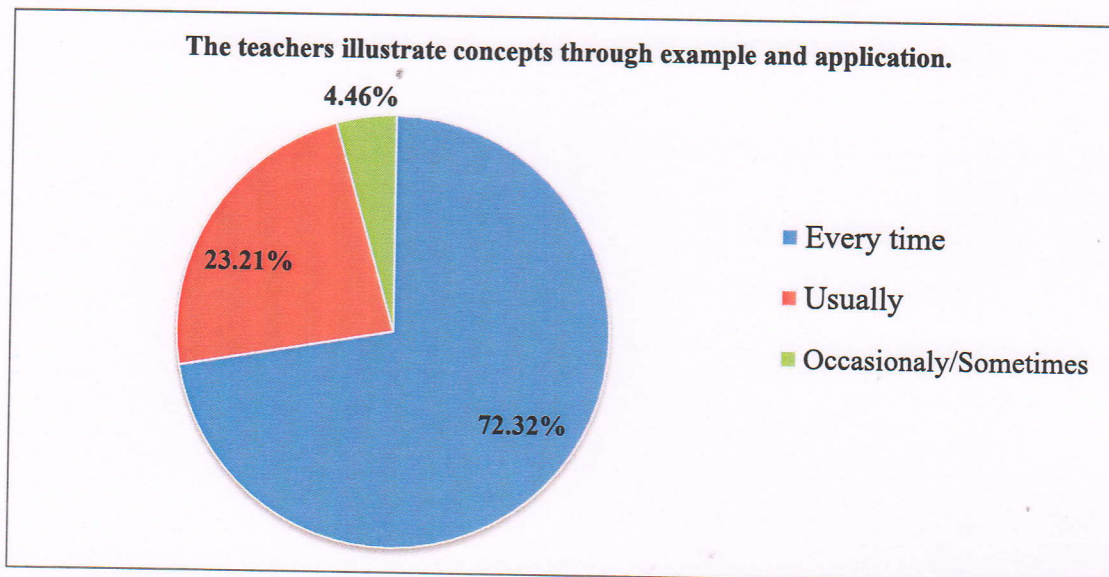
Q.11 Your mentor dose a necessary follow up with an assigned task to you.

Q.12 The teachers illustrate concepts through example and application.

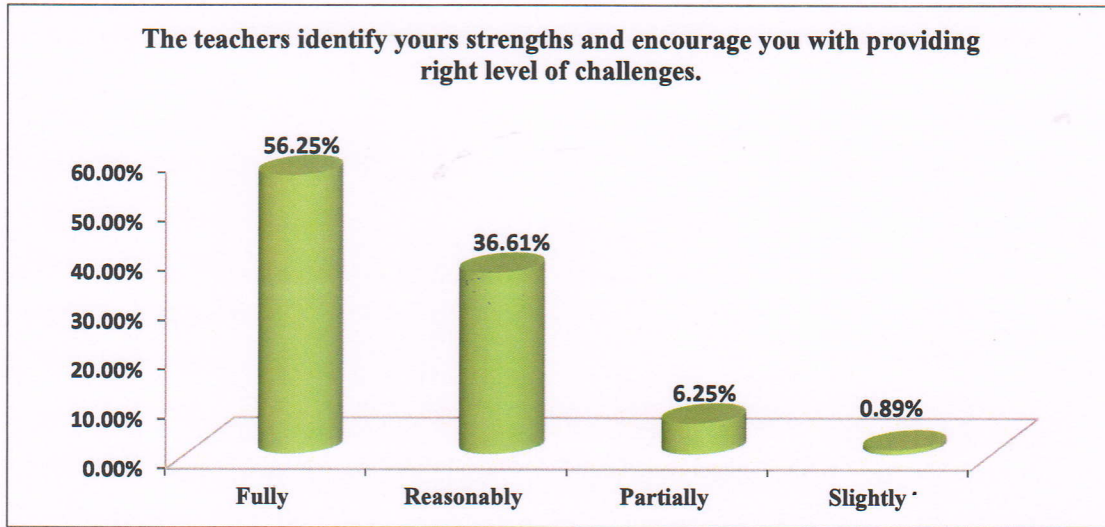

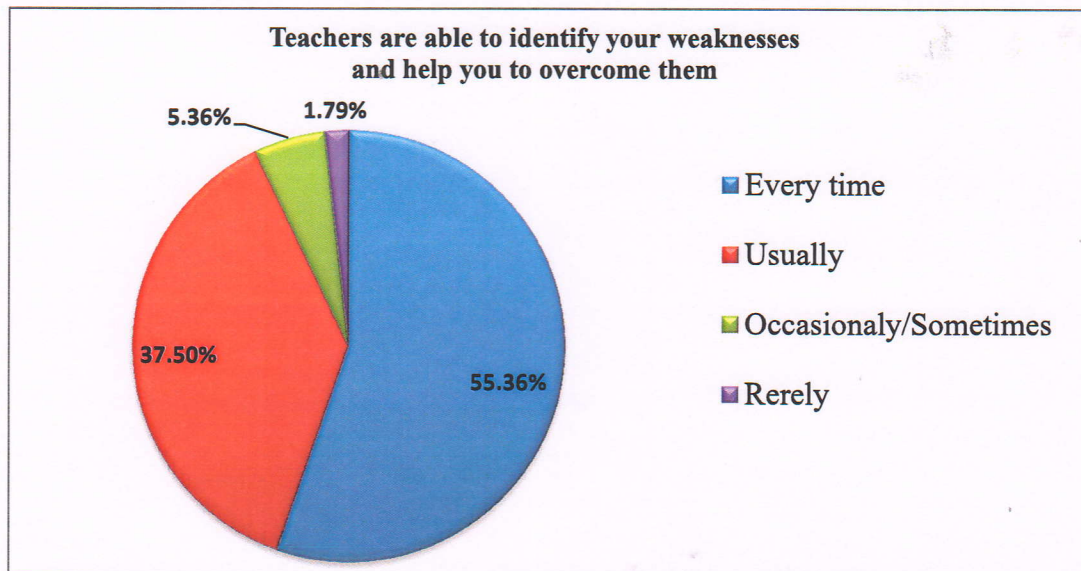

Q.14 Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them

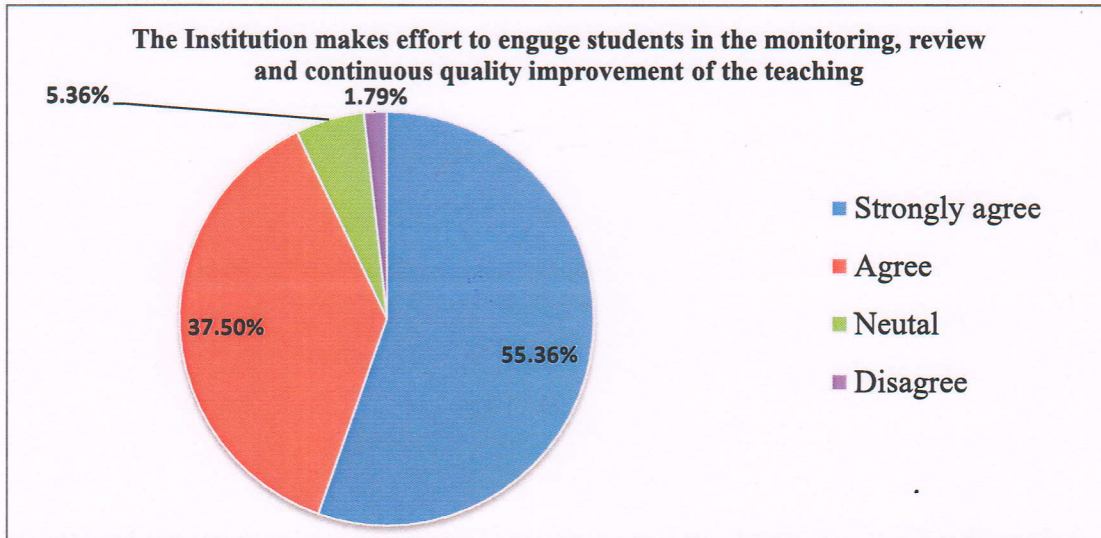

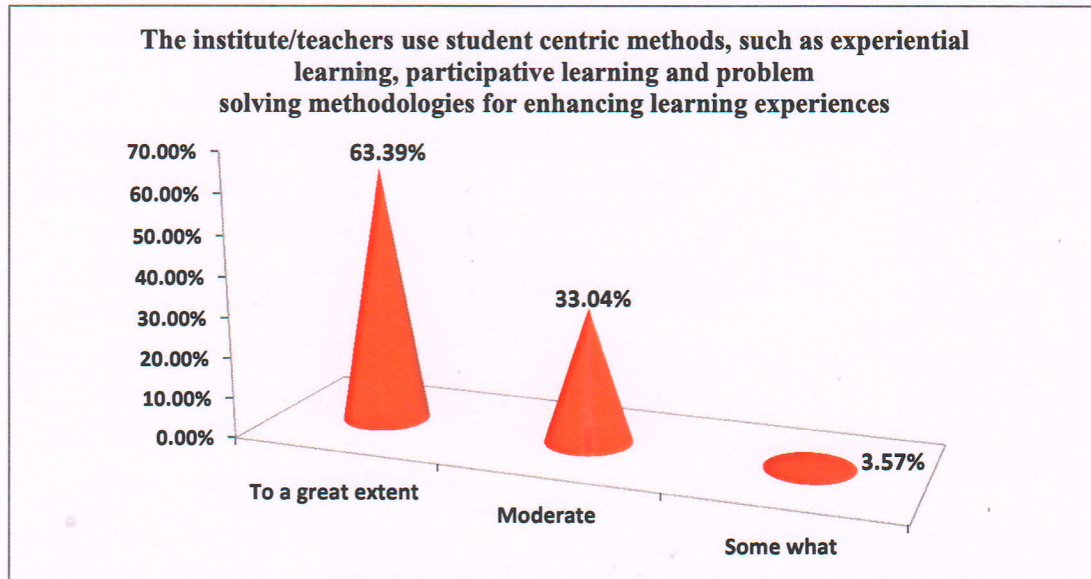

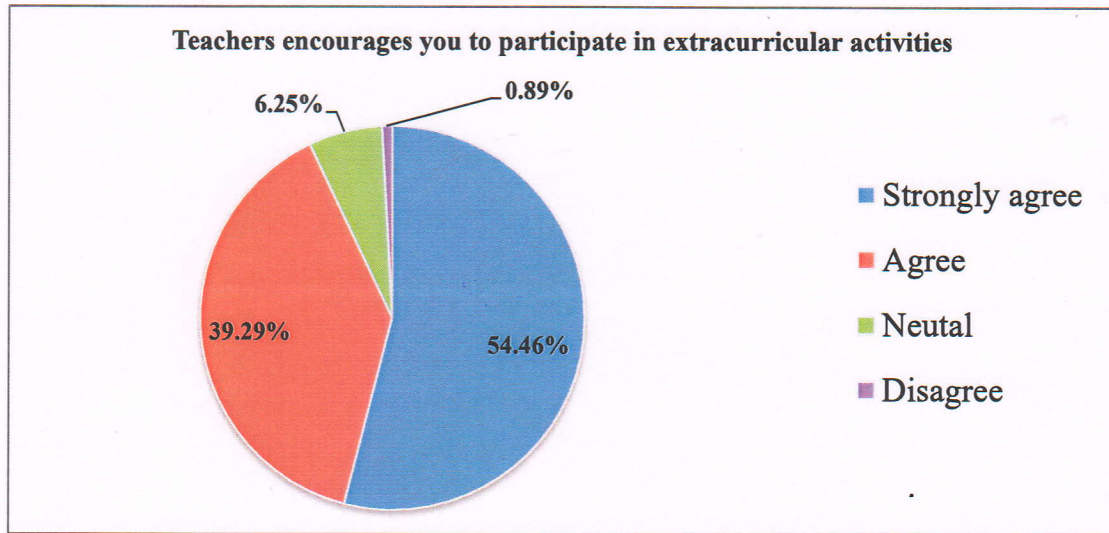

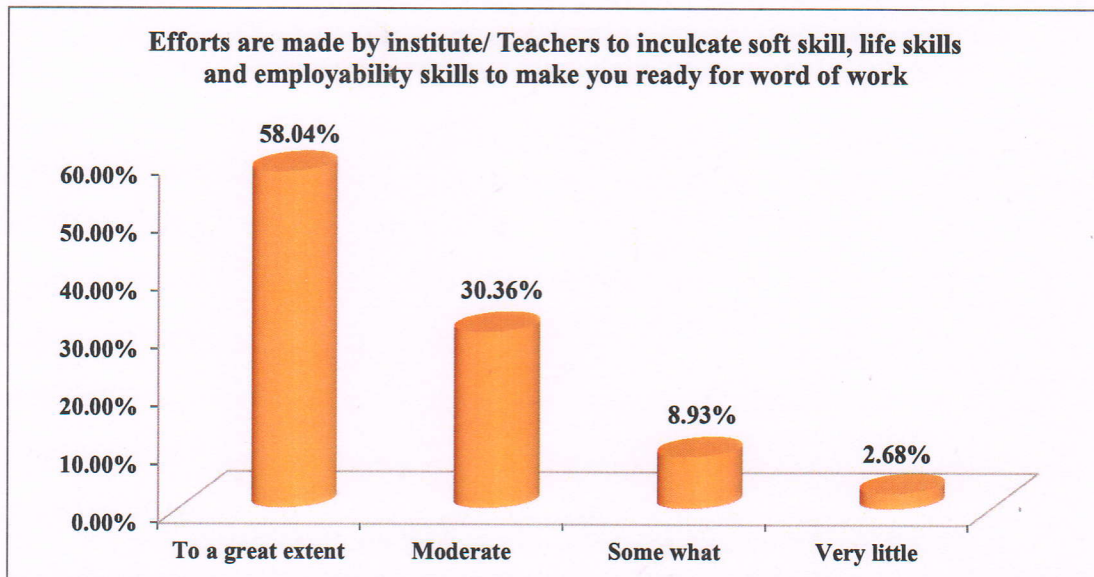
Q.17 Teachers encourages you to participate in extracurricular activities

Q.18 Efforts are made by institute/ Teachers to inculcate soft skill, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for word of work

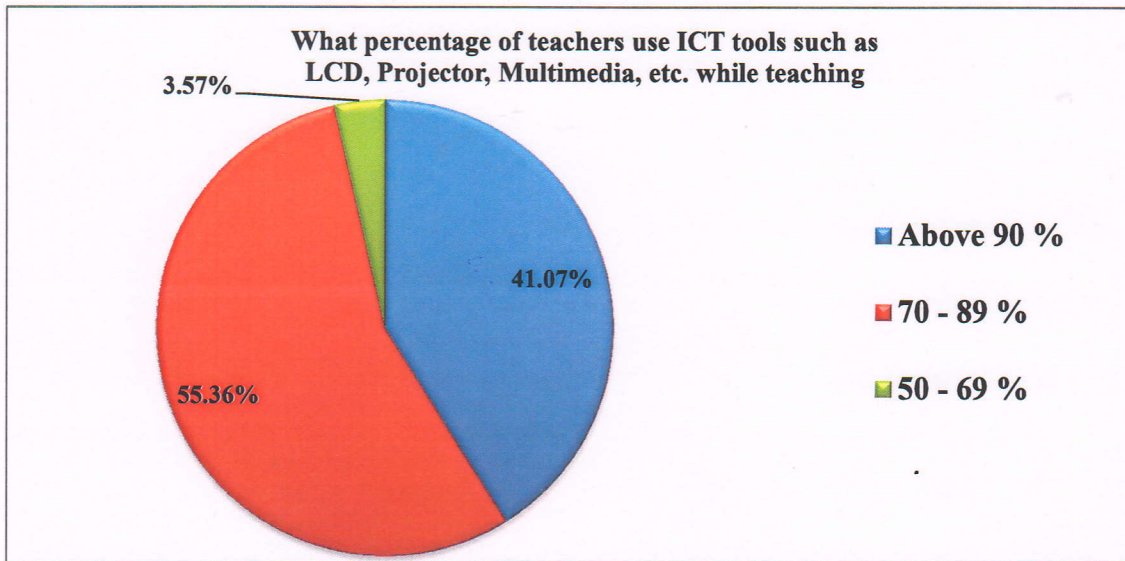

Q.19 What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD, Projector, Multimedia, etc.

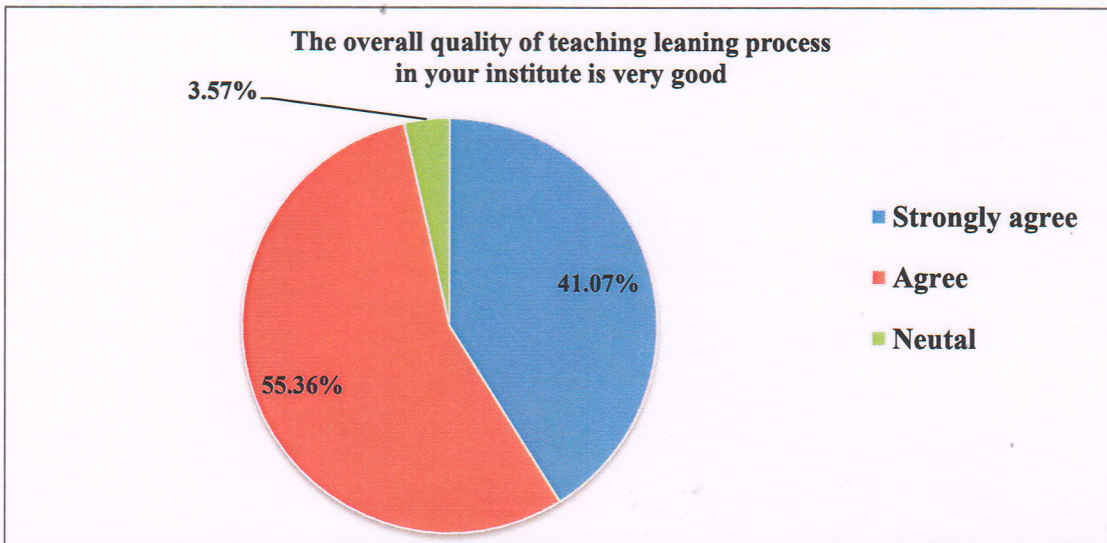
